## This funding will be used to


- Support new staff with coaching to develop capacity to design and deliver differentiated curriculum to cater for diverse learners.
- Implement four lesson sequences of reading and writing and implement phonic program to support early literacy learning to increase reading capabilities of students.

## Our initiatives include

- Implement Read Write Inc program to support early learners with phonic foundations.
- Continue the 4 lesson sequence of reading and writing to continue the improvement of students achieving the National Minimum Standards in Literacy components of NAPLAN.
- Employ a Community Liaison Officer to continue to support families with the enrolment process and connect them to agency to support family well-being.

## Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Fund backfill teachers for a 0.5 FTE Head of Curriculum and 0.5 FTE Support Teacher Literacy and Numeracy to support teachers with coaching and mentoring of reading and writing initiatives.
- Fund a Community Liaison Officer to support community engagement and improve attendance goals.
